THE ESSENTIAL NEED OF GOD'S WORD

"For the Word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing of soul and spirit, of joints and marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart." Hebrews 4:12

There is an old saying that goes: "Dusty Bibles don't make for deep faith." And indeed that is true. For the unbeliever that Bible was given as a roadmap pointing to Jesus for salvation. For the believer the Bible was given for us to grow and deepen our faith beyond our salvation experience. This is what truly makes the Bible so dynamic. It is divine truth given by God for every person to come to the knowledge and understanding of all that God did for us through Jesus Christ His Son. It is this revelation that makes the Bible different from every other book ever written.

What's more, as Southern Baptist we have historically been known as "people of the Bible." In fact, it's what sets us apart from many other evangelical denominations today because we hold the Bible as the one true, sufficient, and authoritative rule of faith and practice. We don't simply believe that the Bible contains the Word of God. We believe it is the written Word of God. As the Apostle Paul wrote in 2 Timothy 3:16, "All scripture is God-breathed." All. Not part. Not a large portion. But all scripture was directed by God for our benefit. As Charles Spurgeon, the great English preacher, once said: "Except for Jesus, the Bible is the second greatest gift God gave to mankind."

All throughout the month of March we will be emphasizing the importance of Bible Study since the singular purpose of Bible Study is to teach the Bible. It's to help every member of our church grow in knowledge and understanding of God's Word. For well over a century Bible Study (Sunday School) has been the discipleship arm of the church and it still is today. For the next five Sunday's we will be having a church-wide breakfast at 8:30 AM, Bible Study at 9 AM, and Worship at 10 AM. During the worship service we will hear testimonies on the importance of the Bible. My hope is that if there are those in our church who are not active in a Sunday School class that this will provide them the opportunity to hopefully get involved. My prayer is that the Bible won't be a dust collector but rather a faith launcher in your spiritual life! Come grow with us!
